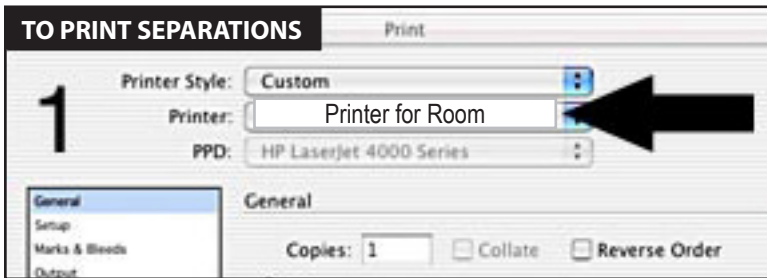

TO PRINT SEPARATIONS

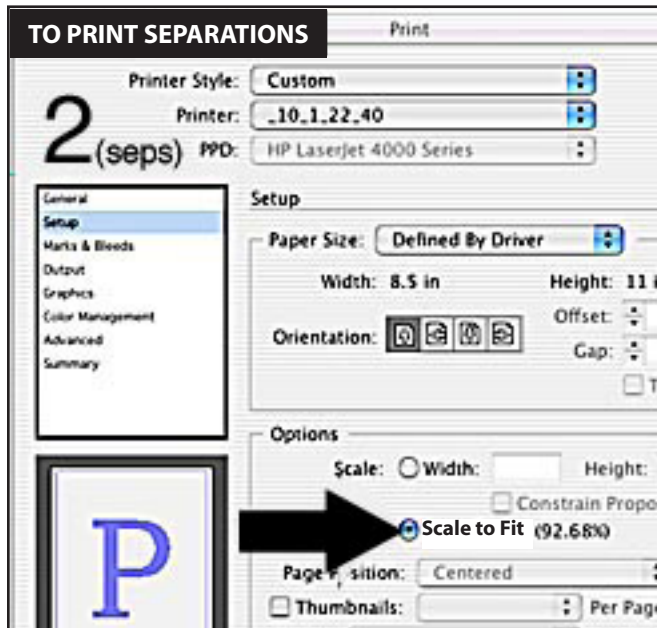


When printing **COLOR SEPARATIONS**, you will need to **SCALE TO FIT (#2)** if the final printed size is the SAME as the paper size.

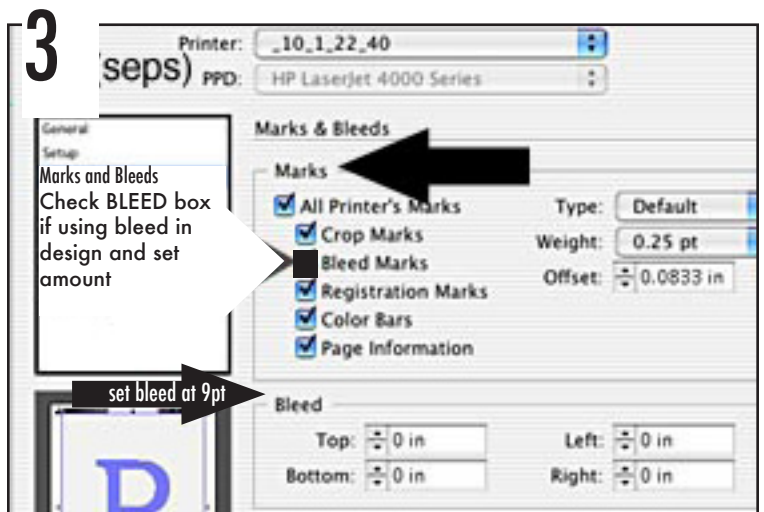
Example:

If your finished printed size is 8.5x11 and the PAPER size is 8.5x11, you will need to Scale to fit so ALL the Printer Marks will fit.

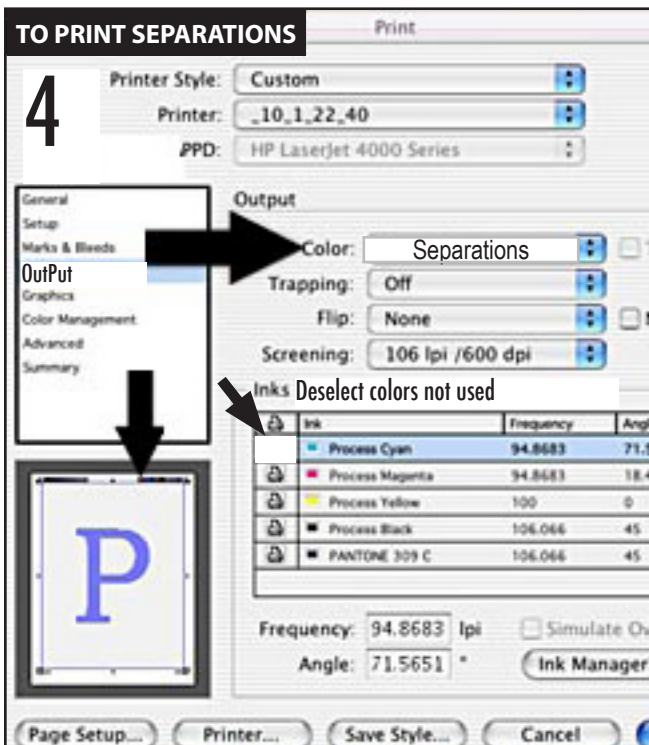

2 PAGE SPREADS TO PRINT SEPARATIONS IN INDESIGN



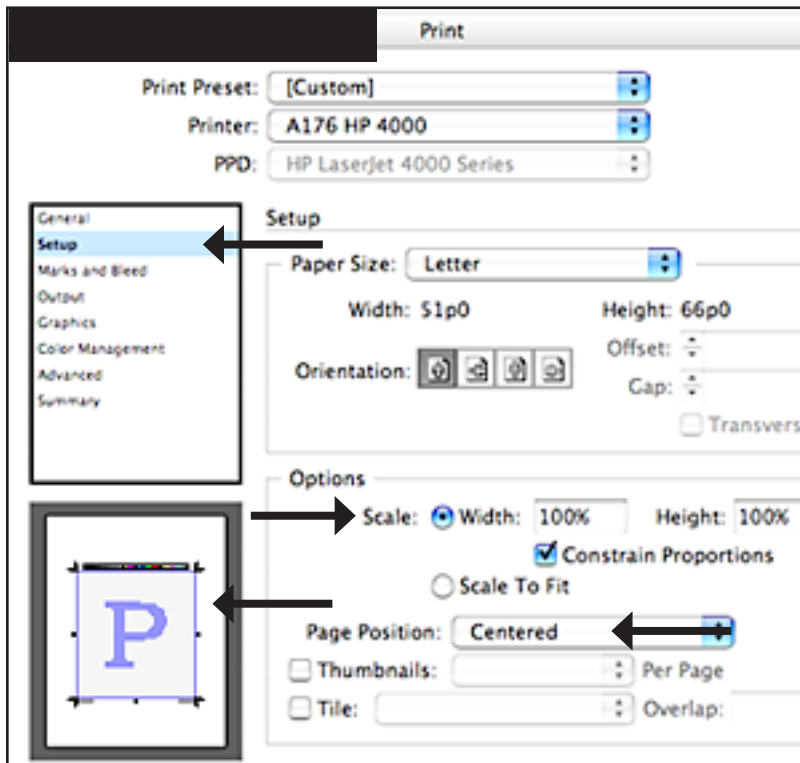


INDESIGN: PRINT WITH MARKS AND BLEEDS

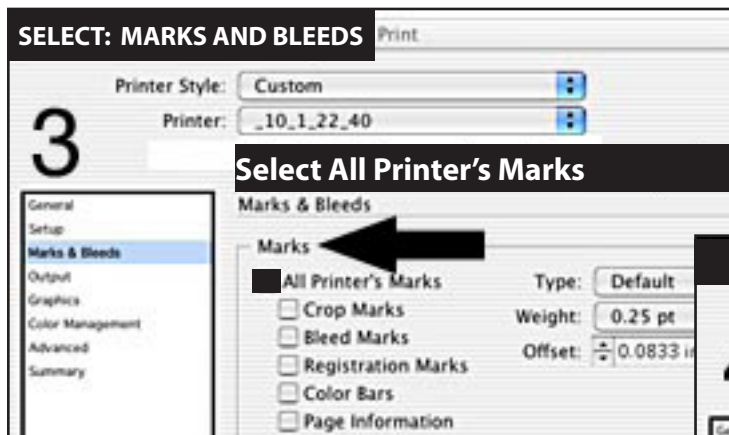
When printing **Printer's Marks**
for a document

Smaller than the PAPER size

Always **CENTER** the document (#2)
and **DO NOT** Scale to Fit.
