

## Full Stack Web Developer

Full Stack Web Developer is responsible for development of web apps, both front end and back end. On the front end, you will collaborate with UX/UI designers to build the user facing part of the app or website, ensuring optimization for usability and layout on desktop and mobile interfaces. This requires knowledge of languages such as HTML, CSS, and Javascript. Knowledge of frameworks like Bootstrap, React, and ReactNative are a plus. As a full Stack Developer, you are also responsible for server-side programming, including form-handling and database management using languages such as PHP and SQL.

Viable candidates will have excellent communication skills and work well on a team of engineers and designers.

## Part 3

Entry level web developers can expect to make roughly \$60,000 - \$70,000 per year. After seven to ten years experience, a web developer may achieve a job title containing the word “senior” with a salary up to \$175,000. The difference in job scope is that a Jr developer will do a lot of code debugging and testing, sifting through code that has been written by more experienced developers and perhaps contributing code in small bits. A senior developer will be more involved in the design and implementation of software architecture, acting as more of a team lead to the less senior developers
