

Web Developer

Job Description:

A web developer is a broad term for a highly trained person who is proficient in responsive design, mark-up language as well as front and back-end programs. This position can take place in an office setting or at home and always requires communication with a client. You're normally building a product/page that meets the needs of your client.

You're expected to know and keep up with a broad range of computer languages, this will make you more desirable. The general required skills include knowledge of **HTML & CSS**, these are the most obvious requirements, as well as, Javascript, which entails moving elements, search bars, interactive maps, etc. Testing and debugging knowledge is also important because you're building pages and need to ensure that they work seamlessly and you need to be able to fix them should anything go wrong. Back-end knowledge is also more desirable because learning how servers work will improve your workflow and allow you to create content efficiently because you're learning how the information is communicated with servers.

Education is not bad compared to other fields. You can complete your formal education in two years but a lot of people have had success learning on their own since the field is growing and is comprised of using computers. Formal education can cost anywhere between \$10,000-\$20,000 depending on where you're going to school.

There are about 4-5 ranks in positions starting at entry level and going up through technical director or head of development. Entry level positions require little experience and schooling. Working an entry level position for a few years will get your foot in the door for your career to go as more places look for years of experience under your belt. Most employers are willing to teach their employees so entry level is a great learning ground.

Comparison of Positions:

I found positions in 3 different cities. The base pay for Entry Level Web Development in San Francisco is about \$63,000, in Philadelphia is about \$54,580 and in Seattle is about \$58,420. This rate seems to go according to the cost of living in each city. The average annual pay for an intermediate web developer is \$81,566 and for a senior level, I found the average to be \$88,000 for senior positions and head of development averages start around \$126,000.

The first position doesn't mention degree requirements or back-end knowledge. The second position in Philadelphia asks for the ability to produce an end-to-end solution and seems like it comes with the most responsibilities. It seems like a project that they are hiring for and have an outcome in mind. The final position in San Francisco seems remote and requires the least amount of experience and doesn't mention an back-end knowledge.
