- For each category of shots below pick a subject and shoot it in each way indicated.
- Shoot 5 seconds of each shot.
- Slate each category and shot [e.g. "Camera Height- High Angle".]
- When you're done shooting, review your assignment and in a document **type** which angle you found most interesting/appropriate for each category and why. Be sure to put your full name on your paper.
 - <u>CAMERA HEIGHT</u> preferably a person or animal.
 - 1. high angle
 - 2. subject level
 - 3. low angle
 - 4. dutch angle/tilt
 - <u>CAMERA ANGLE</u> preferably someone in front of a structure.
 - 5. Straight on
 - 6. 3/4 angle
 - 7. Profile
 - <u>VIEW ANGLE</u> keep subject same size relevant to frame size for each shot.
 - 8. wide angle
 - 9. normal
 - 10. zoom
 - <u>DEPTH</u> these will be two different subjects.
 - 11. shoot a scene that emphasizes depth
 - 12. shoot a scene that is flat that minimizes depth
